



Parr Lumber Delivery Charge Policy

Effective 12/01/2008

1. Minimum Purchase: A \$300.00 minimum purchase for deliveries is standard.
2. Delivery charge per mile:
  - These calculations are based on the products being shipped from the nearest PLC yard.
  - PLC will deliver material at “No Charge” to the customer if the job is in a 30 {road} mile radius from the shipping yard.
  - PLC will deliver material outside the 30 mile radius at \$2.50/ loaded mile. PLC will not charge the customer for the first thirty miles of said delivery.

*Example #1*

- Customer needs a sizeable material package to be delivered to Seaside, Oregon.
- Mileage from our Hillsboro Yard is [approx.] 75 miles. Calculation would be as follows.
- Loaded miles = 75
- N/C deduct - 30
- Charge based on 45 Loaded Miles times \$2.50 = a delivery charge of \$112.50

*Example #2*

- Customer needs a delivery to Hood River, Oregon.
- Mileage from our Rockwood Yard is [approx.] 50 miles.
- Loaded miles = 50
- N/C deduct - 30
- Charge based on 20 Loaded Miles times \$2.50 = a delivery charge of \$50.00

*Example #3*

- Customer needs material at Crescent Lake in C.O.
- Mileage from our Bend store[s] is [approx.] 60 miles
- Loaded miles = 60
- N/C deduct - 30
- Charge based on 30 Loaded Miles times \$2.50 = a delivery charge of \$75.00

3. Additional Charges

- Roofing .....Add ..... \$.75 per bundle
- Concrete, cement, & mixes .....Add ..... \$.75 per bag
- Sheetrock .....Add ..... \$.75 per sheet
- Particleboard .....Add ..... \$.75 per sheet
- Large Doors or Windows.....Add ..... \$25.00 <sup>1</sup>
- Pellets.....Add ..... \$25.00 for the 1st ton <sup>2</sup>

<sup>1</sup> This applies to smaller sized orders requiring two people for delivery]

<sup>2</sup> \$10.00 for any additional tons / Ex. 2-tons =\$25.00, 3-Tons= \$35.00
